About the B³ Workshop

California's structure for funding education involves a dizzying array of categorical programs. SSC's "Building a Better Budget" (B³) workshop is the best source for up-to-date information, tips, and strategies to maximize the impact these dollars have on your educational program.

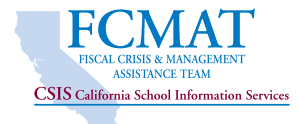
The B⁴ pre-workshop will be held the afternoon prior in all locations except for Ventura.
