

May Revision Workshop

THE MAY REVISION—IMPLICATIONS FOR 2008-09; SUSPENSION OF PROPOSITION 98?

We now expect that energy, housing, and slower growth in state revenues will lead to unexpected changes during the May Revision. While the Governor's Proposed State Budget is the start of the Budget process, the release of the May Revision is when things start getting serious. The May Revision contains final state revenue and Proposition 98 projections that are used for State Budget development—as well as the first indication of the political give and take that is so significant this year. As a result, we again will present our half-day workshop on the Governor's May Revision in 10 locations, co-sponsored by School Services of California (SSC), the Fiscal Crisis and Management Assistance Team (FCMAT), and the California County Superintendents Educational Services Association (CCSESA).

These workshops will again be presented by teams of SSC directors at the special rate of \$125 per attendee, and will focus on the very practical aspects of closing the books for 2007-08 and updating your budget for 2008-09.

We will share information about the financial implications of the Governor's May Revision, including updated State Budget and Proposition 98 projections, up-to-the-minute status reports on categorical programs, and our best projections on the potential impact of the Governor's proposed initiatives. We will also present information related to practical issues involved in closing the books and determining appropriate accruals. Building on the Governor's May Revision as a basis for preparation of the 2008-09 district budget, we will offer information on program rates, provisions, flexibility, and changes to current program funding and operational requirements.

We will also include strategies for collective bargaining and suggestions to respond proactively to financial problems. Finally, we will explain in detail how the statutory COLA was calculated and what it means for the local school agency budget, as well as for collective bargaining.

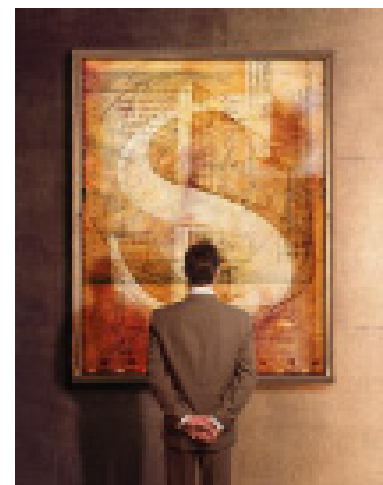
